Spring-Summer 2013 Pilot Test of New FELE Items

The Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Postsecondary Assessment and Evaluation Systems group of Pearson are seeking participants to pilot test items that may appear on the new Florida Educational Leadership Examination (FELE). For each test form completed, participants will receive a cash incentive of \$75.

PURPOSE OF THE FELE PILOT TEST

Pilot-testing is designed to collect information about the performance of new test items to ensure that they are appropriate for use with the FELE program.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO TAKE A PILOT TEST?

Graduate students or recent graduates in Educational Leadership programs and current school building administrators who have taken the exam within the last two years may participate in a pilot test of items developed for the Florida Educational Leadership Examination (FELE). Pilot test participants will receive compensation upon verification of participation. Faculty members who teach educational leadership courses are not eligible to participate in the pilot test.

ADVANTAGES OF PILOT TEST PARTICIPATION (THERE IS NO COST TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PILOT TEST):

For each test form completed, participants will receive a cash incentive of \$75. *Note: Participants may take up to three test forms.*

In addition to the incentive listed above, participants will also: **provide input into the test that will be taken by future educators; gauge professional knowledge by taking actual test items; and gain practical testing experience.**

WHEN AND WHERE ARE THE PILOT TEST?

Computer-based pilot tests will be offered at Pearson Professional Centers and Pearson Authorized Test Centers throughout Florida in the spring and summer of 2013. To schedule a test appointment for the date, time, and test center of your choice, go to <http://www.pearsonvue.com/espilot/>

TEST INFORMATION

Pilot tests include approximately 70-80 multiple-choice questions and/or multiple writing assignments. The session length is approximately 2 hours.

ARE PILOT-TEST SCORES RELEASED?

Because information from the Pilot test will only be used to evaluate the test items, score information will not be provided. Pilot test results will be analyzed as group data only and will be kept confidential. No information that could identify a particular individual will be released.
